WEEE

Directive 2012/19/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 24 July 2012, on waste electrical and electronic equipment - (WEEE).

The Swedish WEEE regulation (SFS 2014:1075) came into force on the 15th October 2014 regarding manufacturer responsibility for electrical and electronic products. The aim is to reduce the impact of disposal and implement a strategy for handling of electrical and electronic equipment at the end-of-life.

Elpress fully comply with the WEEE-directive:

Elpress is targeting to industrial and professional customers, those customers can return products to Elpress at the end-of-life.

Products that are within the WEEE-scope are labelled with a symbol of a wheelie type refuse bin crossed through with a black cross. Information is also given in the products instruction for use.

The full amounts of sold and handled end-of-life products are reported annually to bodies concern.

Elpress is certified to ISO 14001 cert. no EMS 531083 and ISO 9001 cert. no FM 20987, certification body BSI.
